Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is experiential theological education designed to improve the quality of pastoral care offered by spiritual caregivers of all faiths and levels of experience. Our program uses a reflection-action model of learning that integrates components of direct spiritual care, personal and theological reflection, supervision, peer review and supportive group process.

As a student in our program, you will become a part of an interdisciplinary care team that serves hospitalized patients and their loved ones. This direct service facilitates the application of learned theory and your own personal and pastoral experiences as you minister to patients, families and staff. NYC Health + Hospitals/Bellevue is the oldest public hospital in the United States of America. Bellevue offers the best urban medical care in the country. Its historic mandate to serve all people has bestowed upon it a singular responsibility for excellence and humanity in its work. Modern pediatrics, hospital-based psychiatry, emergency and outpatient care, and nursing all were established for the city and the nation at Bellevue.

Programs: <u>2018 Spring (15 weeks program, part-time)</u> February 6 – May 18 Class meets Tuesdays 1:00pm – 6:00pm

> 2018 Summer (11 week intensive unit, full-time) May 29 – August 10 40 hours each week in clinical and educational work

2018 Fall (17 week program, part-time) September 14 – January 14, 2019 Class meets Tuesdays 1:00pm – 6:00pm

The tuition is \$700 per unit. In addition to class time (100 hrs.), students must complete a minimum of 300 hrs. of clinical visitation and evening (5:00-9:00p) and weekend days (9:00-5:00p).

Clinical settings include: Emergency Medicine, Microsurgery, Psychiatry, Clinics and Outreach, Pediatrics, Advance Diagnostics, Clinical Research, Intensive care, Immigrant Health and Victims of Torture, Forensic Unit: Riker's Island Prison Medical/Psychiatric Services.
