## **Announcing 2018-2019 Extended Part-Time CPE Unit**

The New Jewish Home will offer a part-time extended CPE unit internship in 2018-2019. The program runs for 30 weeks, September through April. As an ACPE approved program, it requires a minimum of 400 supervised hours of spiritual care practice and learning. Clinical work is 10-12 hours a week with patients and residents in long term care and post-acute rehab. Clinical placements are available at our Manhattan or Westchester campuses, however each week includes a required four hour educational seminar (Tuesdays 1-5pm) in Manhattan.

Participants may include seminarians, qualified laypeople, and other students who have the motivation and appropriate preparation for spiritual care and who want to learn in a multi-faith, collegial and challenging setting. Students in the CPE unit work with older adults in the long term care and patients in post-acute short-term rehabilitation.

Fall/Spring Extended Unit: Tuition \$700 (due on the first day of the unit unless other arrangements have been made). Scholarships may be available based upon financial need, the amount available in the scholarship fund, and the number of applications received for aid. Additional stipends and other funding may be available as well.
