Dear Ministry Colleague,

Do you have the need and desire to pursue Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) as a part of your pastoral/theological formation. Our Pastoral Care Department and CPE center is located at Roper St. Francis Healthcare in Charleston, SC. We live the mission of **“Healing all people with compassion, faith and excellence.”**

We have more than 25 years of experience providing Clinical Pastoral Education and our program is accredited through the Association of Clinical Pastoral Education (ACPE). Our Faculty has one ACPE Certified Educator and one ACPE Certified Educator Candidate. Our staff also includes pastoral care managers, staff chaplains, five CPE residents and five to six CPE students for every CPE internship. We offer four CPE programs throughout the year:

1. The Fall CPE Program (Sept-Jan) is a part-time unit.
2. The Winter-Spring CPE Program (Jan-May) is a part-time unit.
3. The CPE Summer Internship (May-August / 11 weeks) is a full-time CPE unit with a stipend which could vary depending on hospital budget (Ex. In the 2018 CPE summer unit it was \$ 800.00 per student).
4. The CPE Residency Program (August-August) is a full-time CPE program consisting of four units of CPE. We offer a \$34,000 stipend and health benefits.

Additionally, we work with members of the clergy and church leaders to complete four units of CPE as students (part-time) and assist them in preparing their application to become Board Certified as Professional Chaplains. Also, we are willing to negotiate CPE clinical placements with applicants and we offer the possibility of doing CPE interviews through video conferencing.

We are actively recruiting students for 2019 CPE programs. We are looking for:

- Two CPE candidates for the Winter-Spring extended unit (Jan 14 – May 20).
- Five CPE Summer Interns (May 28 – August 9).
- Three CPE residents (Starting on August 19).

- Five CPE candidates for the Fall extended unit (August 26 – Jan 6, 2020).

Attached to this email is a CPE brochure with more information about our program and a poster to advertise these educational opportunities to your students and alumni who are interested in CPE. There is a \$35 application fee. Our tuition is \$400 per unit.

CLINICAL PASTORAL EDUCATION

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is an intense, 400-hour theological education program for ministers, priests, rabbis, religious and laypersons who seek to learn pastoral ministry in a healthcare setting. This integrated program of theory and practice is directed by certified supervisors in collaboration with a professional staff. Through seminars, lectures, group dynamics, individual supervision and specific assignments, chaplain interns and residents deepen their understanding of their professional/pastoral identity (relationship to others), their personal identity (relationship to self) and their spiritual identity (relationship to God).

PROGRAM GOALS & OBJECTIVES

Clinical Pastoral Education chaplain interns and residents have the opportunity to:

Reflect on and integrate theological, psychological and educational theory with clinical skills in order to develop more effective pastoral care skills

Increase understanding and acceptance of strengths and limitations of one's self and others

Deepen one's spiritual life by sharing the healing role of prayer, scripture and sacraments with others

Become aware of one's personal identity, pastoral and/or professional identity and spiritual identity

Sharpen communication skills, especially those of listening and empathy, and to understand the underlying meaning of the patient's words, actions and feelings

Increase ability to work on a team with healthcare professionals to provide holistic care

Enhance competence in skills such as spiritual assessment, theological reflection and crisis intervention

Increase understanding of the impact of illness and disease on patients as well as on families and other support systems

Increase ability to work within a diverse religious and spiritual framework

Develop skills to bridge clinical learning between the hospital and the local communities, congregations and institutions one serves or anticipates serving

Prepare written material to be submitted to either the Association for Professional Chaplains, the National Association of Catholic Chaplains or the National Association of Jewish Chaplains in order to become certified as a Chaplain.

Full-time Residency

Admission interview for internships are conducted by a CPE Supervisor

Admission interview for residents is on site, unless an exception is approved

Admission interview for supervisory education is on site, and usually involves a full day
