What is Clinical Pastoral Education?

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is clinical training and experiential theological education designed to improve the quality of pastoral care offered by spiritual caregivers of all faiths and levels of experience. Our program uses a reflection-action model of learning that integrates components of direct spiritual care, personal and theological reflection, supervision, peer review and supportive group process. As a student in our program, you will become a part of an interdisciplinary care team that serves our diverse population of residents and their loved ones. This direct service facilitates the application of learned theory and your own personal and pastoral and personal experiences as you minister to residents, families, and staff.

How can CPE benefit you?

Through CPE, you will gain clinical skills that are applicable to any ministerial setting. After completion of four units, you will also be eligible to apply for board certification with the National Association of Catholic Chaplains or other faith certifying associations. Other placements within the ArchCare system may be available. ACPE-CPE training is recognized as a standard for chaplaincy world-wide.

CPE PROGRAMS OFFERED

ArchCare is accredited by ACPE as a satellite of Calvary Hospital to offer Level I and II. One unit of CPE is 400 hours: 300 are direct ministry on assigned resident units or with group programs. Weekday and weekend shifts are available. The remaining 100 hours include instructional and peer group processing. We offer an 11-week, Level I and II intensive unit from May 20th, 2019 to August 1st, 2019.

Terence Cardinal Cooke Health Care Center Summer ACPE CPE program

New summer ACPE CPE program here at Terence Cardinal Cooke Health Care Center (at 5th Avenue and 105th street). As part of ArchCare, we are recently accredited as a satellite of Calvary Hospital and offer level I and II educational programs. The ACPE certified educator for this summer unit is Fr. Andrew Sioleti. We offer an 11-week Level I and II intensive unit from May 20th – August 1st, 2019: it is 5 days per week, 35 hours per week making up 100 hours of class time and 300 hours of clinical time.

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Other clinical placements may also be available at our Mary Manning Walsh Nursing Care Center and our PACE programs.
