**Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is an experience based multi-faith professional education program for ministry. It brings theologically adept lay people, theological students and clergy of all faiths into a supervised encounter with persons in crisis. Out of an intense involvement with persons in need, and the feedback from peers and supervisors, students develop new awareness of themselves as persons and of the needs of those to whom they minister.**

Lenox Hill Hospital, a division of Northwell Health, provides a setting where our students enter into complex social, racial-ethnic, religious and administrative systems and learn how to exercise a variety of pastoral functions within and relevant to those systems. The richness of the cultural and religious diversity at Lenox Hill Hospital is significant. LHH is on Manhattan's Upper East Side, easily reached by public transportation.

**\*The Fall and Spring Units may be combined as ONE Extended Unit (32 weeks) with 9 hours clinical work/week**

**2020 Summer Intensive Unit (11 week program, full-time)**  
May 26, 2020 - August 7, 2020  
40 ours per week (M-F) of clinical and educational work

**The tuition is \$850 per unit.**

**Clinical settings include; General Medical/Surgical, Palliative care, Oncology, Cardiology, Psychiatry, Neurology, Dialysis, ICU and Emergency Medicine.**
