NYU Langone Health is an academic, acute care hospital for the NYU School of Medicine. NYU has offered clinical pastoral education (CPE) since 1985 and CPE programs are currently offered at the Tisch-Kimmel Medical Center in Manhattan with additional site placements at NYU Langone- Brooklyn. CPE students have access to patients in acute and critical care situations. The CPE program has a depth of faculty who participate in the didactics as guest subject matter experts. Also, the program attracts a diversity of students from the numerous seminaries in the area and the many religious communities that are found in New York City. Within the Spiritual Care Department are chaplains of various religious backgrounds who provide opportunities for mentorship and further professional learning.

CPE students provide multi-faith spiritual care to diverse patients and their loved ones in the inpatient and outpatient setting. They work closely with interdisciplinary teams throughout the hospital to develop plans of care that contribute to the well-being of our patients. This direct service facilitates the application of learned theory/academia and personal/pastoral experiences as students' minister to patients, families and staff.

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is experiential theological education designed to improve the quality of care offered by spiritual caregivers of all faiths and levels of experience. Our programs use a reflective practice model of learning that integrates components of direct spiritual care, personal and theological reflection, clinical supervision, peer review and supportive group process. **Current Programs:**

<u>2021 Fall: September 13 – December 20</u> (15 week) Mon. 12:00p – 6:00p + 18 hrs. clinical per week.

2022 Winter: January 25 – May 3 (15 week) Tues. 12:00p – 6:00p + 18 hrs. clinical per week.

2022 Summer: May 31 – August 12 (11 week) Mon. – Fri. 9:00a-5:00p clinical/education per week.

The tuition is \$700 per unit. In addition to class time (100 hrs.), students must complete a minimum of 300 hrs. of clinical visitation.
