Interfaith Professional Education Ministry

Clinical Pastoral Education is interfaith professional education for ministry. It brings theological students, ordained clergy and qualified laypersons into supervised encounters with people in crisis. Intense involvement with patients and family members plus feedback from peers and teachers give CPE students a new awareness of themselves and those to whom they minister.

Providence St. Peter Hospital offers Accredited CPE Program

The CPE Program at Providence St. Peter Hospital is accredited by the Association for Clinical Pastoral Education, Inc. and offers credit for units of CPE. One unit includes a minimum of 400 hours of clinical supervision and education. CPE students gain new perspectives on their ministry through theological reflections on real-life situations, and they develop skills through interpersonal and inter-professional relationships.

Type of CPE Units Offered

We have three programs: Resident, Intensive and Extended. The Resident Program offers a \$35,921.60 stipend with health benefits. We offer a limited number of tuition scholarships.
